SARS-CoV-2 Safety Protocol (revised 8/27/2021)

Pursuant to the Center for Disease Control (CDC) guidelines regarding procedures to protect oneself and others from contracting and spreading SARS-CoV-2, Bourbon Baroque has established the following safety protocol for its artists and constituents while in rehearsal and performance settings:

- **All artists and constituents must be fully vaccinated with appropriate documentation.**
- **All artists must coordinate a SARS-CoV-2 Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) *recommended* OR Antigen (rapid) test as close to time of travel (or immediately upon arrival) and show proof of a negative test result. Bourbon Baroque will assist in covering the cost and arranging a test if necessary.**
- **In order to maintain a safe “covid free” zone, all artists will be required to undergo an additional SARS-CoV-2 rapid test during the course of the project.**
- **All artists and constituents must wear a face mask during the rehearsal process but may remove them during performance especially if wearing one hinders the ability to perform required tasks.**
- **It is expected that all artists and constituents engage in social distancing with face masks outside of scheduled services.**
- **All attendees to indoor Bourbon Baroque performances are required to wear a face mask.**
- **Should an artist’s health or unease regarding SARS-CoV-2 health safety precautions require a resignation from a signed contractual obligation, notification must be given immediately in writing so that a proper replacement can be secured. (compensation in-part will be considered on a case-by-case basis.)**
- **In the instance that a production must be canceled due to SARS-CoV-2 safety concerns, Bourbon Baroque will compensate all artists 50% of the contractual compensation.**
- **Bourbon Baroque is liable for all expenses related to contracted work and will reimburse 100% of all invested monies related to contracted work to the artist including but not limited to travel expenses, SARS-CoV-2 tests, among other variable expenses related to successfully completing the contractual obligations.**
